

DEADLY TORNADO IN MISSOURI SAMARITAIN'S PURSE STEPPING IN

One of the Disaster Relief Units wrapped up its work in Alabama last Sunday and moved to Missouri. Volunteers are removing fallen trees and debris, making emergency repairs on storm-damaged houses, and helping victims salvage valuable possessions. Samaritan's Purse is asking for volunteers to help with this response. "We want to come alongside these homeowners who have lost so much and help them through this difficult time," said Luther Harrison, Director of North American projects for Samaritan's Purse.

The twister killed 138 people as it tore through a densely populated section of Joplin. It destroyed or damaged as many as a quarter of the buildings. Much of the city's south side was leveled, with churches, schools, businesses, and homes reduced to rubble.

City Manager Mark Rohr said the tornado cut a path nearly six miles long and more than a half-mile wide. It hit a hospital packed with patients and a commercial area, numerous smaller businesses and restaurants, and a grocery store.

- That God would direct our staff and volunteers as we respond.
- For safety for Joplin residents and our teams as the forecast is calling for more storms.
